

## **ENTRY REQUIREMENTS**

#### All courses:

- Students must be aged 18 years or over to enrol.
- Students must have successfully completed secondary studies (assessed equivalent of Australian Year 12).

#### **Bachelor & Associate courses:**

IELTS Academic minimum overall band of 6.0 with no individual band below 5.5, or equivalent.

## Diploma courses:

IELTS Academic minimum overall band of 5.5 with no individual band below 5.0, or equivalent.

## APPLYING FOR A STUDENT VISA

Before you can apply for a Student Visa, you will need to receive an electronic Confirmation of Enrolment (eCoE) from SAE. The eCoE can only be issued after you have satisfied all admissions requirements as follows:

- 1. Academic requirement
- 2. English language requirement
- Evidence that you meet Australia's Department of Home Affairs Genuine Temporary Entrant (GTE) criteria
- 4. Upfront payment for first trimester course fees and OSHC costs

## MEETING THE GTE CRITERIA:

Your individual circumstances must demonstrate you genuinely intend to stay in Australia temporarily, for the purpose of completing a qualification. SAE may ask for evidence that supports you in meeting this requirement.

#### **ESOS ACT**

Australia's laws promote quality education and consumer protection for overseas students. The Education Services for Overseas Students (ESOS) Act 2000 and the National Code 2018 are designed to protect the interests of students coming to Australia on student visas. The legislation aims to protect and enhance Australia's reputation for quality education, to provide tuition protection and support the integrity of the student visa program. ## SUPPORT SERVICES

## **HEALTH COVER**

International students\* are required to purchase visa length Overseas Student Health Cover (OSHC) in order to have their enrolment finalised and Confirmation of Enrolment (CoE) issued.

OSHC is compulsory insurance that provides cover for the cost of medical and hospital care which you may incur while in Australia.

We advise arranging healthcare directly with an OSHC provider; further information (including a list of preferred providers) can be obtained from the Department of Home Affairs website:
